### NARI OF MADISON HISTORY

NARI of Madison was founded in 1983 and has seen steady growth in it's membership through membership meetings, educational events, chapter networking opportunities, consumer awareness endeavors and community service projects.

NARI of Madison is currently the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest chapter in the country and has had the highest retention rates amongst large chapters year of year. Showing our commitment to our members and their businesses.

### NARI OF MADISON MEMBERSHIP

NARI of Madison ended 2024 with a net positive growth for the third year in a row. After a small decline after the pandemic, our chapter is committed to continued growth and even more importantly a high net retention rate. We ended the year at 242 members and 93% net retention. We are currently the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest chapter and have strong presence in the Madison and Dane County area. We continue to strive to make NARI a household name and spreading the word of NARI and the professionalism our association is known for. Our members have seen measurable increases in their businesses by building their networks thru NARI of Madison.

We host 9 General Membership Meetings throughout the year and almost all have an educational portion to them so that our members can continue to grow their knowledge and expertise and stay current. Beyond our membership meetings, we host other social events so that our members can continue to grow their networks as well.











### NARI OF MADISON LEADERSHIP





### NARI OF MADISON COMMUNITY SERVICE

NARI of Madison is committed to giving back. In 2024, our chapter took on two community service projects our first being a refresh of the landscape and outdoor area at a skilled nursing facility in Evansville, WI and our next one partnering with NARI Madison member, Logan's Heart and Smiles for putting up a fence for a family in need in our area for a family that special need children.

Evansville Manor Landscape Project

Our first visit in 2023 consisted of tackling the front entrance to the facility and managing the rugged, forgotten landscape projects and paint refresh at the home. In 2024 our crews came back for a day of giving back. This year, we tackled their outdoor resting spot and gazebo area. This area had been neglected for years causing overgrown flower beds, weeds to numerous to count and general disarray of this area that should be a relaxing spot to chat with loved ones. This year's goals & task list included: install pollinator plants, install a new flowering tree, reduce mowing maintenance with new beds, install a temporary watering system, and plant a bunch of tomato, pepper, edible flower, and herb plants in the host of pots and planters existing around the outdoor gazebo.

#### Fencing Project

In June, we partnered with our local non-profit member, Logan's Heart and Smiles and we tackled a fencing project for a family in need. We gathered volunteers and materials to complete a fenced-in backyard project for a family that has two special need children, who are flight risks, so they weren't able to use their back yard as much as they would like in fear that the kids would leave the area. Our team got to work side by side with Logan's Heart and Smiles crew and had volunteers show up for a day long project of completing this task. We were able to provide a peace of mind for the family so their kids could enjoy the outdoor space without the risk of leaving the yard.













### NARI OF MADISON WFD TRADES DAYS


In 2024, NARI of Madison partnered with the Madison school district to provide "Trades Days" for 2 local schools. These "Trades Days" were whole day sessions to bring forth different career opportunities in the remodeling industry to high school age kids. We provided volunteers and handson activities for the students to learn about these professions and further teach the students about career alternatives to four-year schools. Our focus was covering activities in the following areas:

- Carpentry
- Electrical
- Plumbing
- Tile
- HVAC

We had volunteer members train and teach the students at about each of these careers and answer questions about what training and/or schooling, make connections with students and to showcase trades careers. We have more "Trades Days" planned in 2025!










### NARI OF MADISON GIVES BACK

NARI of Madison Education Foundation was founded in 2011. This is the philanthropic arm of NARI of Madison as our 501c3 foundation. The Foundation was specifically created to provide and support educational opportunities to enhance and develop remodeling professionals. Our mission is to provide scholarships for local trades schools, high schools and NARI member employees to promote the remodeling industry. To date, our Foundation has given over \$40,000 in scholarships to local trades schools.







## NARI OF MADISON WOMEN IN CONSTRUCTION



NARI of Madison has partnered with our local builders associations to create the non-profit group Women in Construction in Wisconsin. Our mission of this group is to gather women in the otherwise male-dominated industry of residential construction to meet quarterly to network, provide educational sessions and workshops and provide an outlet for women in the industry to gather and be a voice for women in the industry.

We started our own Build X Conference a one day conference focusing on empowering women in the construction industry and we are going on our 4<sup>th</sup> year in 2025 and had over 300 women from Wisconsin attend in 2024. We provide educational speakers, panel discussion and hands on activities for the women to participate in. In 2024, we gave out our first ever scholarships to women who were going into construction fields and we plan to continue these scholarships each year.












### NARI OF MADISON EDUCATION

NARI of Madison is committed to expanding knowledge in several ways for our members. Beyond the certifications that NARI offers members, NARI of Madison is dedicated to educating members at our local membership meetings. Each month we provide a topic for a seminar before each lunch or dinner meeting. These topics range from general business topics, legal, marketing, HR to specific trades topics like code updates, OSHA, mold and asbestos, design, etc. Many of these seminars qualify for our local state dwelling contractor continuing education credits and NARI credits for certified members.

Prior to the pandemic, we partnered with our local trades school and started offering small classes for our members called Carpenter Upgrade Classes. These were designed with the novice carpenters on staff and member companies with maybe only a year or two under their belt that could use a brush up of simple skills they see on the job. We've held over 10 classes that sell out each time. The topics cover things like, window and door installation, trim and molding installation, stairs, cabinet installation, exterior trim and siding to name a few. We use the facility at Madison College and their tech instructors to teach these classes and past NARI members as well. They are four, three-hour evening classes, so they don't interfere with the workday. The feedback has been overwhelmingly positive and we strive to continue to train the workforce for the remodeling industry!












### NARI OF MADISON PARTNERSHIPS

NARI of Madison not only partners with Madison Area Builders Association and Milwaukee Area Builders Association for our non-profit group of Women in the Construction Industry of Wisconsin, but three years ago we partnered with Madison Area Builders Association to change the name of our Remodeling Expo that we have had for over 20 years solo to create the Build & Remodel Expo. This has been an exciting partnership bridging not only remodeling professionals but new home construction professionals together to engage homeowners at our home show. This partnership has been an extreme success with us selling out home show participation each year of this partnership. Our director has fostered the relationship with the local builders association to not only provide an exceptional home show that is the only locally run home show in the Madison area, but we have joined forces in other ways to expand the knowledge of the trades industry as a whole to create a strong force in the Madison area surrounding the residential construction industry. Our director has encouraged other chapters to use their local builders association's as an ally, and not just a direct competitor for members. Combining our forces in the community has proven to be a win-win for both of our members and has led to some additional membership within NARI as well!


